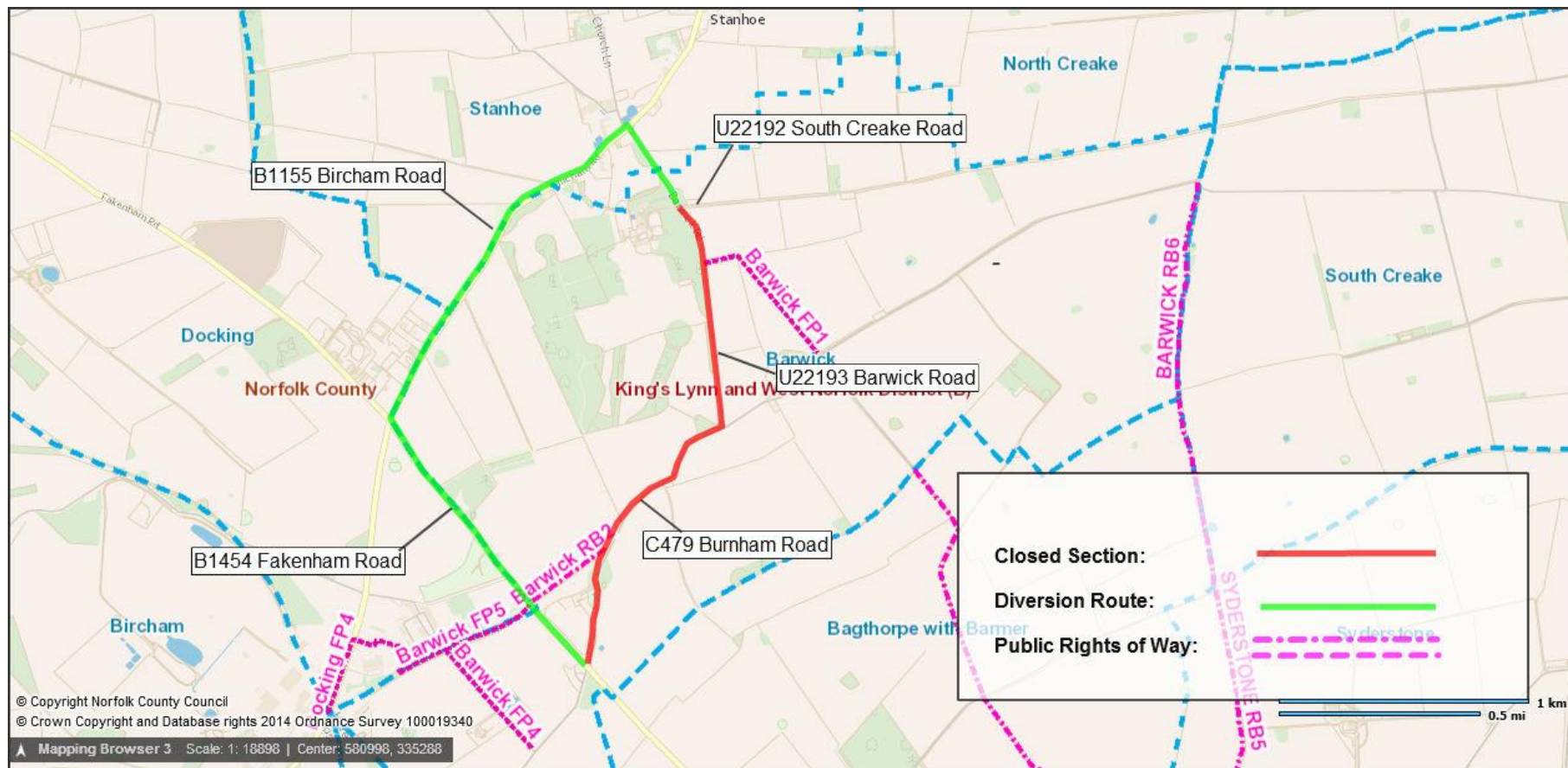

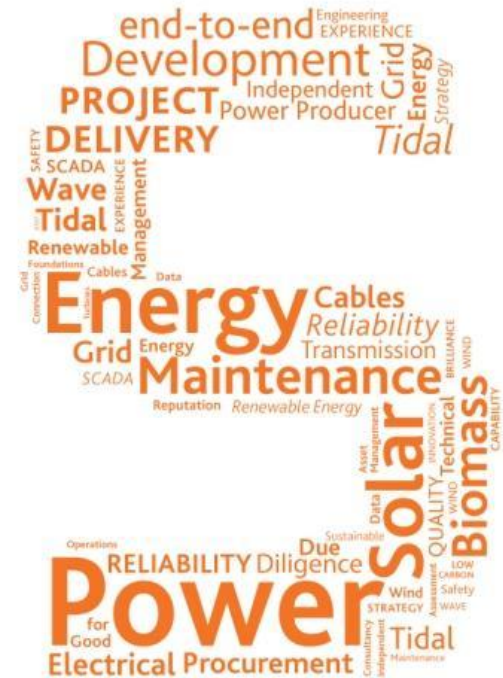

- LEDS has been developed in response to feedback from local communities
- Offers residential, community and business properties closest to RES' Jack's Lane Wind Farm an annual discount off their electricity bills
- Discounts paid directly to the electricity supplier will commence once the wind farm is operational
- No requirement to change electricity supplier or tariff

LEDs - Eligibility

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2014 LICENCE NUMBER 0100031673.

- Turbine Locations
- 2400m Set Distance
- Postcode Geographic Boundaries
- Postcode Geographic Boundaries Eligible for LEDs

The Qualifying Area has been defined by taking a straight line distance - the Set Distance - from each wind turbine and identifying all the postcode geographic boundaries (as defined by the Ordnance Survey) with properties located within this Set Distance (i.e. 2,400m).

Properties located outside of the 2,400m Set Distance are only eligible if they are located within the same postcode geographic boundary as properties located within the Set Distance.

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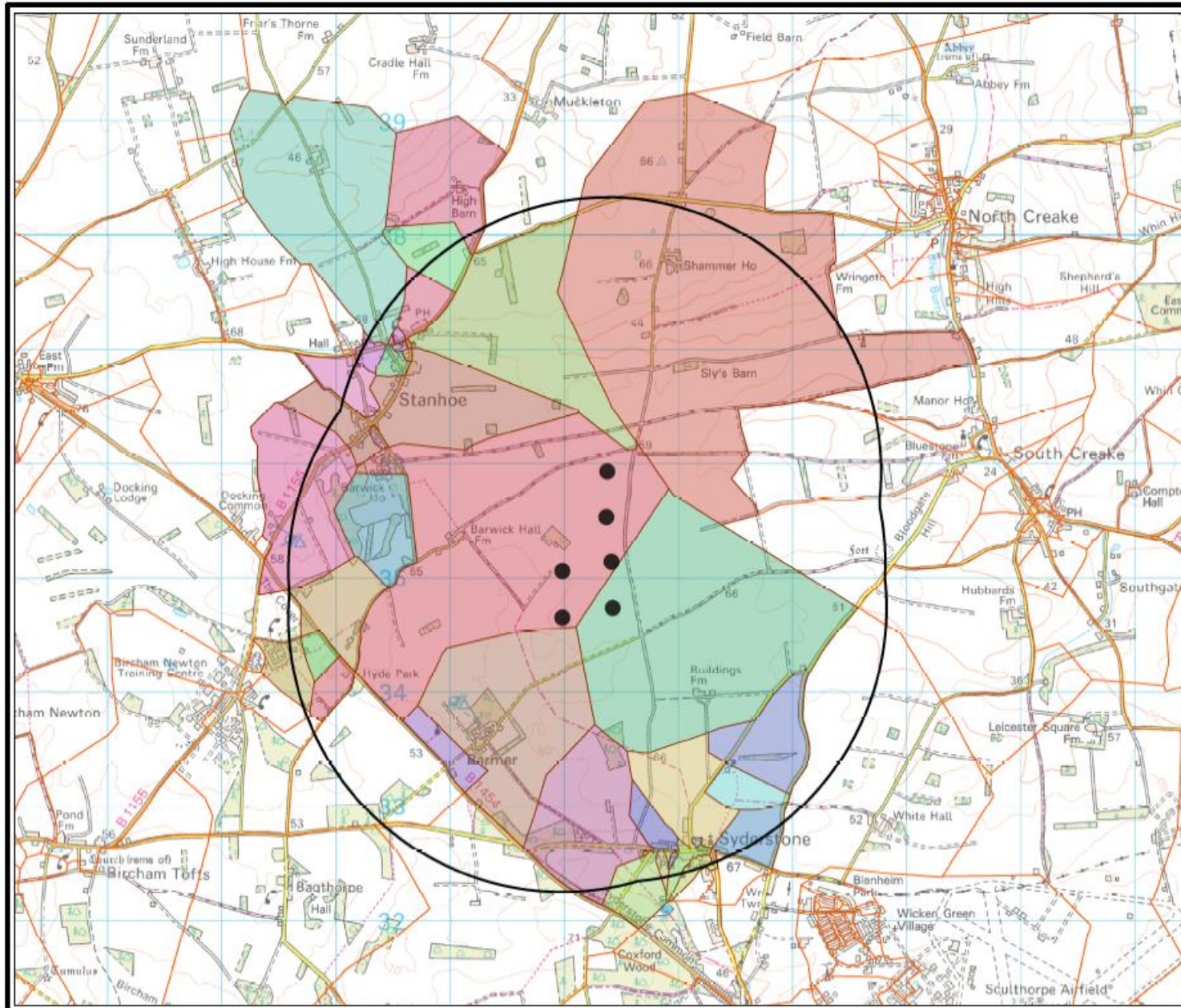

Local Electricity
Discount Scheme

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- £100 discount paid directly to electricity supplier
- 467 eligible properties sent joining packs in December 2014
- Deadline of 31 January to be guaranteed this year's payment
- RES will endeavour to process applications received after this date in order to make the first payment but this cannot be guaranteed

- 60% of properties have sent in their details to apply to the scheme to date
- RES will aim to make first LEDS payment within 6 weeks of the wind farm reaching full operation
- Eligible properties will be written to directly with information on when they should expect to see the discount credited to their account.

The Jack's Lane Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund will support local groups and initiatives in the wider community.

£30,000 per year (index linked) will be paid annually for the 25 year lifetime of the project.

First payment made within one month of wind farm 'take over' date.

The Norfolk Community Foundation is the Fund Administrator.

Norfolk Community Foundation (NCF)

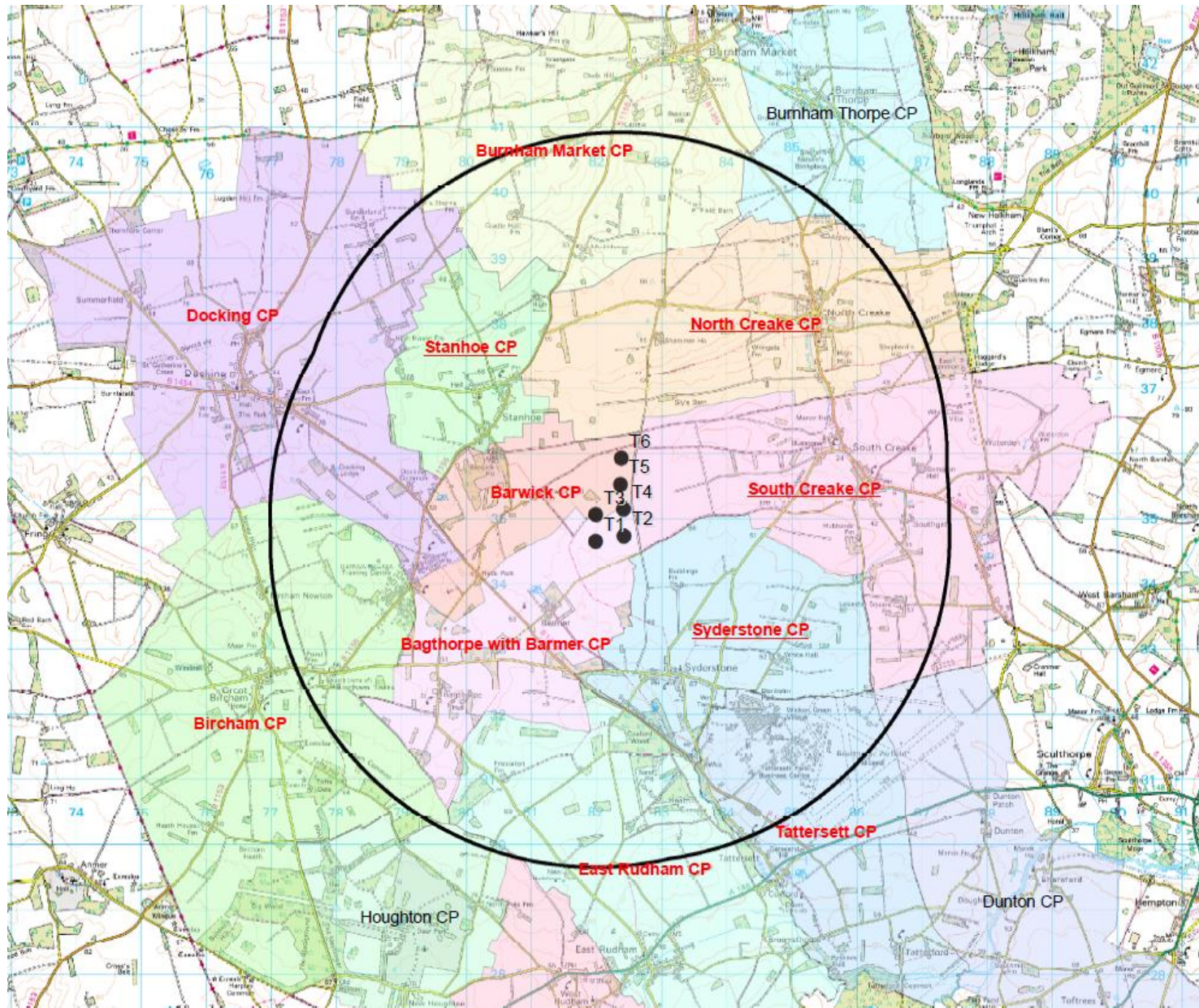
Remit:

- receive the annual Fund payments
- work with the Fund Panel to finalise fund criteria
- handle enquiries from applicants
- process grant offers and payments in line with Fund Panel decisions
- deliver annual reports to RES

To make sure that the Fund is invested locally, RES specifies an **Area of Benefit** to the Fund Administrator and Fund Panel.

Having consulted the CLG at past meetings, the AOB has been set at 5km.

Area of benefit - 5km radius



The constitution of the panel is as follows:

FOUR permanent members - one 'suitable representative' from each of the following parishes of **North Creake, South Creake, Stanhoe and Syderstone**

The remaining FIVE places selected on a rotational basis will come from the following seven parishes of **Bagthorpe with Barmer, Barwick, Bircham, Burnham Market, Docking, East Rudham and Tattersett**

A Chair will be nominated by the panel and shall have the casting vote if required

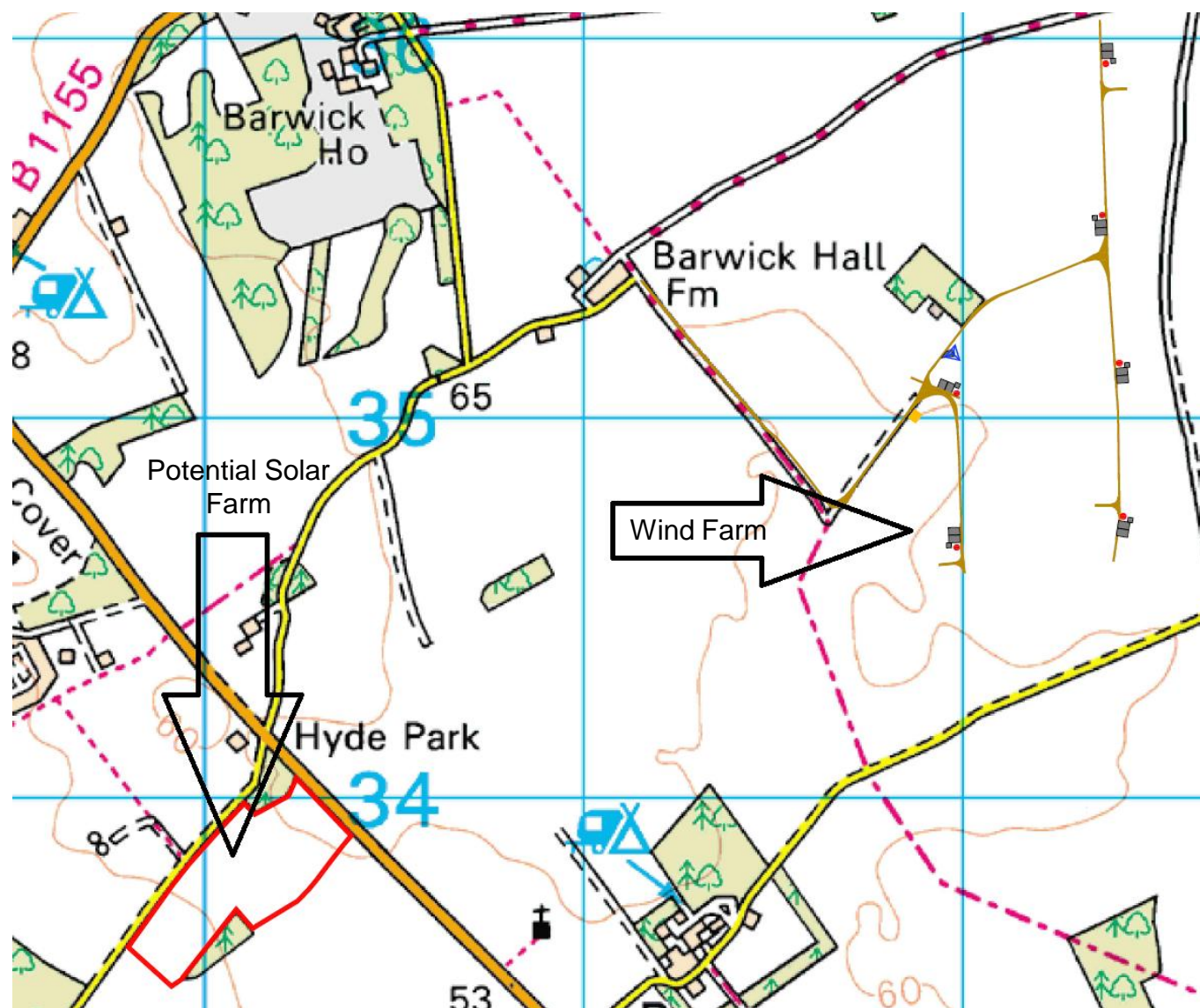


Four Burrows - Site of a RES developed, constructed and operated wind farm 20 years ago with same landowner.
